<u>James 3:5-6</u>, "So also the tongue is a small member, yet it boasts of great things. How great a forest is set ablaze by such a small fire! And the tongue is a fire, a world of unrighteousness. The tongue is set among our members, staining the whole body, setting on fire the entire course of life, and set on fire by hell." (Damaging to the person spewing it out...and damaging to those that hear).

# The Tongue Can Be One of the Greatest Tools for Blessing that God Ever Gave to Man.

#### With the tongue:

...We can bless or we can curse man...and God.

Let no corrupt thing come out of your mouth.... "Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen."

#### Words can lift...or they can harm.

The Holy Spirit is pleased when we are honest and upright, both with our fellowman and with our God. Dishonesty in any form grieves the Spirit of God.

The tongue can either be an unruly member or one by which we praise and bring glory to God.

"A wholesome tongue is a tree of life; but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit" (Proverbs 15:4).

"Death and life are in the power of the tongue... (Proverbs 18:21a).

It is wise for us to remember that one day in judgment, God will recall all the things that we have said. Remember, there is great power in speech.

A doctor can tell much about the physical condition of a man or woman by looking at the tongue. When you go to see the doctor, he will say to you, "Stick out your tongue." A healthy tongue is a good sign, but if it has a yellow or white coating, or has certain marks upon it, that is an indication of an unhealthy body.

Sometimes I think the Lord says to us spiritually, "Stick out your tongue." As we stick it out, we ought to let the Lord sanctify it and make it holy.

Mother used to quote this little tidbit...I bet yours did, too.

"Be careful of the things you say, Keep them soft and sweet; For you never know from day to day which ones you will have to eat."

# Even the method by which we are saved is by the tongue—speaking a confession.

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved" (Romans 10:9).

"But...the tongue can no man tame"...part of James 3:8.

God can tame the tongue...He gets into the spirit man. Then...the mind, thoughts and the physical body line up.

Proverbs deals with every kind of question man has in life! The question is after reading Proverbs...Will You Make the Right Choices?

Someone might say, "But...How do you know which of the two or more choices is right? The Answer: Always...Always...That which your conscience controlled by the Holy Spirit tells you to do! So...let's realize that we have a partner helping us in times where critical decisions have to be made.

#### With the tongue we can bless God...our fellowman...help another! Or...We can disappoint God...our family...our friends...and ourselves.

<u>Psalm 104:34</u>, "May my meditation be pleasing to him, as I rejoice in the Lord."

<u>Psalm 49:3</u>, "My mouth shall speak of wisdom; and the meditation of my heart shall be of understanding."

<u>Psalm 104:34</u>, "My meditation of him shall be sweet: I will be glad in the Lord."
